This note outlines what schools currently need to consider as we begin implementing new minimum stipend levels and new benefits plans for postdocs which take effect July 1, 2023.

Provided below is immediate guidance regarding stipend increases and postdoc offer letters. Please share with your relevant staff and offices. Additional implementation instructions will be forthcoming. If your school has biomedical postdocs, BPP will update the appointment letter template and provide guidance on how to complete the appointment letters.

Stipend Level Actions and Rules

## **<u>Stipend Notes</u>**: All postdocs must be provided the new Penn stipend minimum for their total years of postdoc experience no later than July 1, 2023.

<u>Benefit note</u>: Non-NRSA postdocs will receive Workday notifications to enroll in benefits. Enrollment timeline is April 24 to May 5, 2023, for July 1, 2023 enrollment, which is the same as for Faculty and Staff benefits enrollment. NRSA Postdocs will be contacted by Gallagher to re-enroll in their benefits for July 1, 2023.

Action – Appointment or Reappointment Letter Language recommendations:

- All **new** postdocs who have received an appointment letter, must receive a revised appointment letter with updated language regarding their stipend levels and benefits.
- Recommended Benefits Language:
  - Postdoctoral Researchers and Fellows:

Effective July 1, 2023, individuals in postdoctoral positions at the University of Pennsylvania can participate in the <u>Penn Postdoc Benefits Plan</u>. Postdoctoral Researchers and Fellows at the University of Pennsylvania are required to participate in a medical insurance plan. If you are currently enrolled in a medical insurance plan with at least comparable coverage and wish to continue that coverage, you may choose to waive participation in the University's program.

• <u>NRSA Fellows:</u>

Effective July 1, 2023, NRSA Fellows at the University of Pennsylvania can participate in the <u>Penn Postdoctoral Insurance Plan for NRSA Fellows</u>. Individuals in postdoctoral positions at the University of Pennsylvania are required to participate in a medical insurance plan. If you are currently enrolled in a medical insurance plan with at least comparable coverage and wish to continue that coverage, you may choose to waive participation in the University's program.
